Hi all

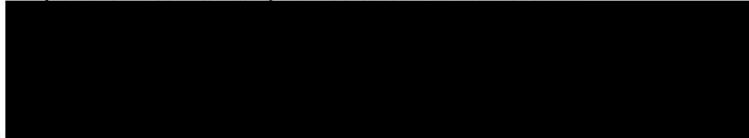

This wording for STRmix statements had the opportunity for input from all reporting scientists in meetings in 2013 and as an outcome, the wording was standardised and put into the 17119 SOP.

There were many reasons for this, and apart from an important point of standardisation, it was to help any scientist to pick up any statement at any time and be comfortable with the wording, and also to help reviewers efficiently perform their task with minimal disagreement.

Can I please ask that we stick to the standard wording in the interests of the above as we need to put all our efforts/time into getting the large amount of work to our clients.
