Any references to QP numbers, names or addresses or contact details of any person or site, and names of police operations or details that may identify victims of crime or persons of interest the subject of current investigations, that are contained or visible in documents tendered during public hearings, whether accessed on the Commission website or not, shall not be published or made publicly accessible, until the relevant investigation has been finalised.
- 4. Any references to covert police strategy or methodology including locations of DNA sources that are contained or visible in documents tendered during public hearings, whether accessed on the Commission website or not, shall not be published or made publicly accessible.

- 3. Any references to QP numbers, names or addresses or contact details of any person or site, and names of police operations or details that may identify victims of crime or persons of interest who are not aware that they are persons of interest the subject of current investigations, that are contained or visible in documents tendered during public hearings, whether accessed on the Commission website or not, shall not be published or made publicly accessible, until the relevant person of interest becomes aware, or ought reasonably to be aware, that they are a person of interest, the relevant investigation has been finalised.
- Any references to covert police strategy or methodology <u>including locations of DNA</u> sources that are contained or visible in documents tendered during public hearings, whether accessed on the Commission website or not, shall not be published or made publicly accessible.
