The data excludes Person Samples and Reference Samples, although that data can be provided if required.

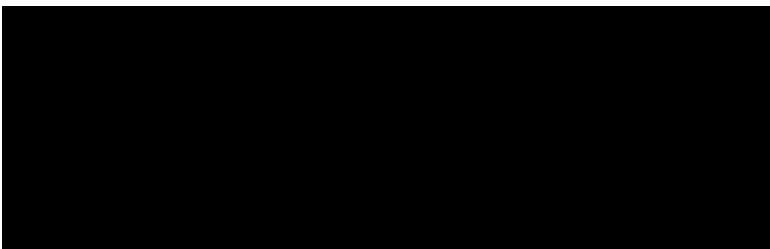
The supplied workbook contains the following tabs:
